## Symbol Key

**CA = California Native:** Californian native plants are adapted to wet winters and dry summers and may only need supplemental irrigation during abnormal dry seasons.

**☆ = Summer-Dry:** Summer-dry plants do not like to be watered in the summer. Supplemental water may be required during dry winters. Summer-dry plants like water in late winter/early spring, during the plants growth period. Most California natives are summer-dry.

**♻️ = Very Low-Water:** For efficient use of water and to support plant health, place plants with similar water needs in the same irrigation zone. Once established, very-low water plants do not need irrigation, unless there is an unusually dry year.

**♻️ = Low-Water:** Low-water use plants perform with small amounts of supplemental water.

Note: Observe the health of your plants. Depending on different soil types, sun exposure and other environmental factors, once established, plants may or may not need additional watering.
